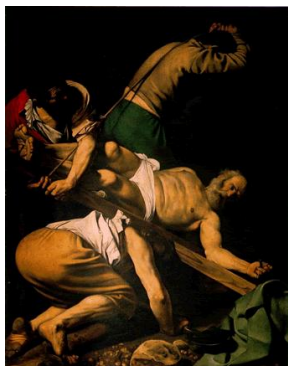
CARDINAL'S APPEAL UPDATE
