WORLD YOUTH DAY

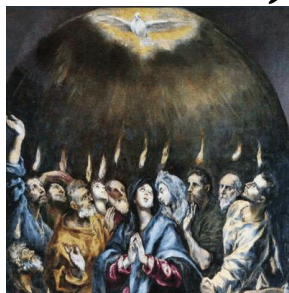
Assumption Church is seriously considering joining Pope Benedict for World Youth Day in the summer of 2011 in Madrid Spain. Please contact the rectory for more information.
